Registrants must be barred to practice in the State of Maryland, and agree to accept one (1) *pro bono* family law case each year, for two (2) years, the first one within the next 12 months. ***Prior experience in family law is NOT required.*** Failure to complete the commitment will result in a fee assessment of \$200 for the training and materials provided.

The cases will be pre-screened and assigned through a legal service provider (Legal Aid Bureau, Maryland Volunteer Lawyers Service, Women's Law Center, or other similar agency). Cases are typically located in Baltimore City and Baltimore County, but other jurisdictions may be available. Attorneys may request a specific jurisdiction. The case may involve contested custody and/or property issues. A Family Law Mentor will be assigned to assist participants in the handling of these matters. To the extent the participating attorney does not have malpractice coverage, such coverage will be provided by the referring agency, upon notice to such agency.
