



# EXPUNGEMENTS

## ELIGIBLE DISPOSITIONS

<p><b>Nolle prosequi/Not Guilty/Acquittal/Dismissal/Transfer to Juvenile Court</b></p> <p>z § § E</p>	<p><b>Stet</b></p> <p><u>Waiting time:</u> 3 years from disposition date</p>
<p><b>Guilty for a nuisance crime</b> (ex. loitering, drinking alcohol in public, failure to pay fare)</p> <p><u>Waiting time:</u> 3 years from the completion of your sentence before filing</p>	<p><b>Not criminally responsible for a nuisance crime, trespass, telephone misuse, and disturbing the peace</b></p> <p><u>Waiting time:</u> 3 years after you were ruled not criminally responsible</p>
<p><b>Guilty for CDS possession/paraphernalia, Trespass, Misdemeanor Theft, Prostitution, Disorderly Conduct, B&amp;E of a Vehicle, Unauthorized Removal of Property</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Waiting time:</u> 10 years from the end of sentence/probation</li> <li>• No other convictions during your sentence/probation or for 10 years after your sentence/probation</li> <li>• You must wait for any conviction you receive to become eligible for expungement</li> </ul>	<p><b>Guilty for Assault 2nd, Felony Theft, 1st, 2nd, 3rd Burglary, CDS Possession with Intent to Distribute, or Common Law Battery</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Waiting time:</u> 15 years from the end of sentence/probation</li> <li>• No other convictions during your sentence/probation or for 15 years after your sentence/probation</li> <li>• You must wait for any conviction you receive to become eligible for expungement</li> </ul>
<p><b>Probation Before Judgement (PBJ)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Waiting time:</u> 3 years, or the length of the probation, whichever is longer             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DUI/DWI are not expungeable</li> </ul> </li> <li>• If you were convicted of another non-expungeable crime within 3 years of this PBJ, the PBJ cannot be expunged</li> </ul>	<p><b>Guilty for Marijuana Possession</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Waiting time:</u> 4 years from disposition date</li> <li>• Amount of marijuana no longer matters</li> </ul>
